

AGREEMENT & RELEASE FOR PAINTING OVER GRAFFITI

This Agreement and Release is entered into by the Broadway Business Improvement Area (“BBIA”) _____ (“Owner”).

BACKGROUND:

The BBIA operates a graffiti prevention program that supports the removal of graffiti from private property by our maintenance contractor – CleanScapes. Property owners who would like CleanScapes to paint over graffiti on their property must agree to the following:

- 4. Owner releases the BBIA and CleanScapes from all claims, damages or suits, of any nature, arising out of the performance of this Agreement by CleanScapes.
